



## Future I-57

As part of the Future Interstate 57 (I-57) corridor, the Arkansas Department of Transportation will construct an approximately 42-mile, four-lane Interstate Highway between Walnut Ridge and the Missouri State line.

The Future I-57 project addresses a gap in the system linkage that diminishes connectivity and mobility of the National Highway System. South of Walnut Ridge, Highway 67 is a fully-controlled access facility connecting to I-40 in North Little Rock.

North of the Missouri border, Highways 67 and 60 are either built or planned to be built to a four-lane interstate-type facility to Sikeston, Missouri. From Sikeston, existing I-57 heads north through Missouri and Illinois until it ends in Chicago, Illinois.

The segment of Future I-57 between Walnut Ridge and the Missouri State line was selected due to the alignment minimizing the environmental and social impacts to the greatest extent possible while satisfying the purpose and need of the project.
